HOW to apply

WHEN to apply: Deadline January 31, 2012

WHAT is required:

- A completed electronic CSL Funding application
- A community venue (clinic, community center, church or other place where clients may be receptive to health-related services)
- Evidence that the proposed project meets a community expressed need
- Commitment to minimum of 40 hours of community service (including planning, preparation, mentorship and reflection)
- Monitoring and evaluation strategies that will allow outcomes reporting of the impact of your service-learning intervention
- A poster presentation at the Annual Community Service Learning Conference



The Center will award a limited number of \$2000-\$5000 midi-grants in 2012-13 to strengthen community service learning in four areas of identified need, including mental health. We hope that through the mentorship afforded by these opportunities, we will inspire a greater number of health professionals to care for people with mental illnesses.
